Major changes in exam assessment began in September 2016.

Some subjects were Reformed in Sept 2016, making them “linear” subjects, with the whole of the assessment at the end of a course. For subjects listed below, marks achieved at AS level do not contribute to the final A level.

Students continuing to Upper 6 in these subjects will **not** have an opportunity to re-sit.
