The following is a list of activities you may like to do during your summer holidays, in preparation for studying Law.

Watch the following:

- Watch an episode or two of 'Silk' to get an insight into the workload of a Barrister.

Select a University you feel you might like to attend after College:

- Research the entry requirements for a degree in Law at your chosen University.
- Research the course content and the available optional modules offered at your chosen University. This will give you an idea of what will be expected of you if you wish to pursue a career in Law.

If you are serious about a career in Law you might like to consider how you could obtain work experience in a law firm and begin writing to firms to try and arrange this.

Current Affairs

During the course of 2018 it has become apparent that there is a massive gender pay divide in many companies. The BBC have reported examples of more than 15% pay gaps in favour of men at a variety of companies. However, in order to combat this, organisations with 250 or more workers must now publish their figures by April 2018 and 527 firms have already done so.

With this in mind, carry out your own research into the gender pay divide, finding specific examples in the media where there has been an obvious pay divide, any Legislation that exists surrounding this issue and why organisations are now required to publish pay figures.

Over the summer, you might like to:

- Research the particulars of one specific case and the particulars of what pay divide existed
- Laws on equality between the sexes
- Examples of organisations seeking to rectify the problem
