Are you interested in studying Film? Want to have a go at making a Film or TV programme?

Students will be asked in advance to prepare an idea or a few ideas for a short film with up to 4 actors shooting in either a simple set studio, or in a location on campus, which would need pre-approval, such as the library, canteen, Students' Union bar, a classroom, sports hall or anywhere else on site.

Shooting will take place over 2 days in groups of 8, with one group having 4 people in the crew and potential of up to 4 actors who shoot for one day then the group switch crew/acting and shoot a different film the next day.
