

## **Level 2 Progression Policy 2023-24**

Following an application to the College, students are interviewed according to the Admissions Policy. Subject choices are agreed on condition that the student will be qualified for each individual course upon enrolment. Students are further advised on Introductory Day and Choices Day. The final programme of study is confirmed at the enrolment interview in September.

Students enrolled on a Level 2 programme of study are encouraged to progress to a Level 3 programme of study. All Level 2 students are enrolled on a one year programme leading to BTEC Level 2 qualifications and potentially GCSE and Level 2 Literacy or Numeracy qualifications.

## 1 Progression to a Level 3 programme of study at the College in 2024-25

A student following BTEC Level 2 courses and GCSE re-sits will be guaranteed progression to a Level 3 study programme if they meet the following requirements in the academic year 2023-24:

- Merit or higher grades across all their BTEC Level 2 courses
- GCSE grade 4 in Mathematics or English Language (or a Pass in the Level 2 Literacy or Numeracy Qualification
  if taken instead of the GCSE)
- At least 95% actual attendance in lessons
- Excellent punctuality to lessons, typically 95% or above
- An average of a grade 3 or above in all Interim Reports
- Exemplary behaviour, whether in lessons, around College, in the local community, representing the College or when travelling to or from College

Students will be informed of a final decision (where possible) in June or after L2 examination results are published in August. Parents will be notified of this decision in writing.

## 2 Progression at the Assistant or Deputy Principal's discretion

• Where a student does not meet the above requirements due to extenuating circumstances, his/her/their progression to a further course at the College will be at an Assistant or a Deputy Principal's discretion.
