All Lower Sixth and Intermediate students are expected to take part in *at least one* enrichment activity.

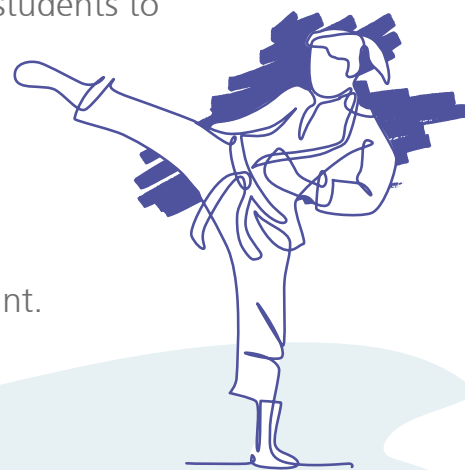
Take a look at what's available in 2024-2025:

1 Clubs and Activities Programme

During one of your first College tutorials you will be asked to download the MyEvolve app. This is the app the College uses for students to book onto particular Clubs and Activities.

Pick from around 50 lunchtime and after College extra-curricular clubs and activities - from Knitting to Trampolining, Rock Band to Self Defence.

2 Competitive Sport

Alongside the recreational sport offered through the Clubs and Activities Programme, the College also fields competitive teams in: Men's Football (three teams), Women's Football, Men's Rugby, Women's Rugby, Netball and Basketball.

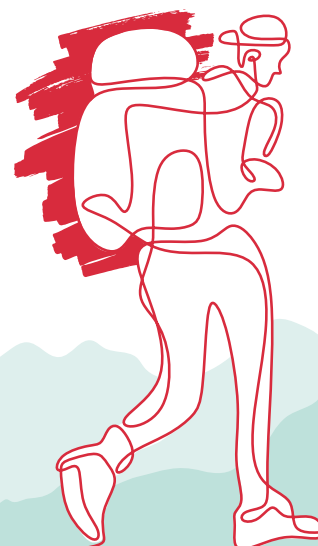

6 **Students' Union (SU)**

The SU is responsible for organising and running a whole variety of social and fundraising events as well as being a channel of communication between the student body and College Management.

SU events and activities form a big part of College life and have recently included: Freshers' and Leavers' events, swap shops (for clothes and books), 'Love Week' in February, 'Charity Week' in March, 'Menstruation Stations' (to highlight period poverty), cake sales, pop-up events such as hot chocolate give-aways, Film Nights, Gratitude Week, Green Week and Equality & Community Day.
