The Independent Learning Centre (ILC) is a two-story, state-of-the-art building designed for students to use for independent study and timetabled Structured Learning



Opening times:

Monday to Friday, 8am to 4.30pm (term time)

ILC

The ILC has PCs for students to use outside class for individual course-work, and access to e-mails, the College network and the College virtual learning environment; these include Teams, Sharepoint and My PD (personal development site). All students are expected to work independently and in silence. The centre is supervised throughout the day to ensure that a good working environment is maintained for all.

Software

All PCs are equipped with standard software including Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Chrome. Students can also access specialist software including Photoshop and 2D Design.

Printing

Students working in the ILC have access to a number of printers for printing, copying and scanning.

Helpdesk

The ILC is supervised by ILC staff during opening hours to support students in their academic work. Staff can help individual students with enquiries and are responsible for maintaining an appropriate working environment for everyone.

Additional services

The ILC keeps copies of College textbooks to support a range of subjects along with a selection of fiction books to be read for pleasure.

A variety of subject related magazines are also available: current issues are displayed on a stand in the ILC, whilst back issues are held by departments.

The ILC is an excellent resource for all students at the College and students are naturally expected to show respect for each other and the staff working in it.

It is an academic environment where students come to study independently and in silence.
