

## How employers can help with the delivery of Reigate College's Careers Programme

### » Offering work experience

#### This might be through

- **Hosting an 'Insight Day' or half day to a small group of students.** Students would be shown around different areas of your company and meet with your staff in a variety of roles. Activities such as a mock interview, team activity or preparing a presentation are also very useful
- **Providing work experience for one or more students.** This could be one to five days during College holidays or during our work experience week in July

### » Coming into College

#### This might be through

- **Giving a talk** on topics such as career paths in your organisation, what skills employers are looking for, applying for apprenticeships and other opportunities such as work experience for future employment
- **Delivering a workshop for students** - this could be linked to an aspect of the curriculum, on developing employability skills or on making successful employment applications
- **Meeting with teaching staff** to develop aspects of the courses we offer to better align with skills that employers value
- **Attending one of our college events** such as the evening Meet the Employer event that we host in May
